

Workshop on Intraseasonal Processes and Prediction in the Maritime Continent

The WGNE Madden-Julian oscillation (MJO) Task Force, S2S, and Meteorological Service Singapore (MSS) are organizing a workshop on "Intraseasonal Processes and Prediction in the Maritime Continent" on 11-13 April 2016 in Singapore. The goal of the workshop is to advance understanding of MJO – Maritime Continent (MC) interactions with the intention of improving subseasonal prediction in the MC and globally, supporting the joint research effort between the MJO Task Force and S2S in this area. Topics to be discussed include interactions of the MJO in the MC region with: diurnal cycle, synoptic variability, the monsoons, ENSO, the land surface, the ocean; NWP and climate model simulations of subseasonal variability in the MC region with a focus on: Model bias and other errors and subseasonal prediction.
